**Peter Hume** - Peter Hume is the Chief Strategist at HP Urban Inc. A development company that helps landowners and builders navigate the complex world of municipal approvals. Peter is a former City Councillor for the City of Ottawa serving on City Council for 23 years. The last 10 years as Chair of the Planning Committee. Among his many accomplishments were the revitalization of the Aberdeen Pavilion, the redevelopment of Lansdowne Park and the Ottawa River Action Plan. In addition to serving on Ottawa City Council Peter is a past President of Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) and served in that role for most of the August 2008 - August 2011 term.

He was a long serving member of AMO's Board of Directors and a member of the Hydro Ottawa Board. He is also a former Board Member of Waste Diversion Ontario (WDO) and former chair of the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC).



**David Wise** - David is the Manager of Policy Planning, responsible for overseeing implementation of Ottawa's New Official Plan, meeting the twin challenges of Housing Affordability and Climate Change, and is the principal in charge of overseeing development of the New Zoning By-law – a fundamental re-write of Ottawa's land use regulations to make Ottawa the most livable mid-size City in North America. During his career with the City, David has been involved in a variety of projects, including clearing the way for the Missing Middle, design guidelines and regulations for high-rise buildings, adopting a

"landscape first" strategy towards front and rear yards, and most recently, laying out a strong template and policy framework for neighbourhood uplift city-wide.
